**FORT PIERCE, Fla.** — As Florida surpasses more than 10.1 million Floridians vaccinated, COVID-19 vaccinations are being transitioned to a locally-led effort through primary care providers, retail and pharmacy locations, county health departments under the Florida Department of Health and local governments. As a part of this transition, the St. Lucie County Health Department will continue to coordinate with local community providers to ensure vaccine access for all St. Lucie residents.
