More than 1.2 million people in the U.S. are living with HIV infection and 1 in 8 of them don't know it. As of 10/31/2016 Florida had recorded 114,256 presumed living HIV/AIDS cases with 1,617 living in St. Lucie County (Florida Health, Disease Control, November 2016 Monthly Surveillance report)

"Through advocacy, partnerships and collaboration tremendous progress has been made in addressing the needs of the community. As we continue our commitment to our community, we extend a personal invitation to the residents of St. Lucie County to join us in Stopping The Spread of HIV by "Passing The Message, Not The Disease," said Dawn Jones, Area 15 – HIV/AIDS Program Director.
