## DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM



Under section 385.204, F. S., the state of Florida operates a safety-net program to purchase and distribute insulin and diabetes management supplies to residents.

**The Insulin Distribution Program is a safety-net medication program for those that cannot afford their medication or diabetes management supplies. The program exists in every county in the state of Florida.**

### **YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE IF**

- You are a permanent Florida resident
- You are diagnosed with diabetes
- You are uninsured, lacking insurance that covers insulin or diabetes management supplies, or have an insurance deductible or copay that the applicant cannot afford, and
  - Have a net family income at or below 100% of the federal poverty guidelines, and
  - Have no more than \$2,500 in private funds, bank accounts, or assets, other than a homestead
- You are not a current Medicaid recipient
